NLBS ride – Sunday 21st May 2017

PLEASE NOTE START TIMES BETWEEN 12.30 PM AND 1.30 PM

1. The venue for the ride is Dolphinholme House Farm LA2 9DJ. **Please do not approach from Dolphinholme village as there is a weak narrow bridge over the River Wyre.** Please see also website at www.dolphinholmecountryride.co.uk
 - Directions to Dolphinholme House Farm below:-
 - From the M6 junction 33 roundabout, turn towards Garstang then immediately left (Hampson Lane) Follow this over the motorway for about half a mile. Turn right and follow that road for about 1 mile going straight over a crossroads. You will arrive at the Fleece Inn. Go straight on along Chipping Road from the side of the pub.
 - Go straight on at the first cross road and follow the bends until you cross the River Wyre.
 - Just after, at the second junction, keep left and left again onto Wagon Road.
 - Dolphinholme House Farm is clearly marked about half a mile along this road on the RIGHT.
 - SatNav PostCode is LA2 9DJ
2. The route includes bridleways and lanes and some concessionary routes. Please be sure to heed the signs and markers. There are some stony sections on the route and riders will need to take appropriate care, both on these sections of the ride and at any road crossings. There are also some shallow water crossings.
3. Please be aware that the route does go near a site where there will be clay pigeon shooting taking place on the morning.
4. Some of the gates on the ride will be manned to assist riders. However, on the Nicky Nook part of the ride, gates will not be manned. Also, this section of the ride is a popular route for dog walkers and ramblers – please be considerate to other users of the track!
5. The length of the ride is approximately 12 miles. Unfortunately, on this occasion, a shorter route is not available.
6. There is a cross country course at Dolphinholme House Farm which will not be available on the day.
7. If the weather leading up to the date of the ride is very wet or the ground conditions are unsatisfactory in the opinion of the organisers, the ride may be cancelled, in which case any cheques will be destroyed. Further details on this will be available on the website nearer the time of the event.
8. Parking at the venue is limited and so numbers on the ride will be restricted. Please note that no entries will be allowed on the day. Please indicate on your application form if you are bringing a trailer or lorry as this will help us plan the parking arrangements. Parking for lorries will be in a different area to that for trailers. If it is possible for riders to share transport, this would be a great help! Please indicate accordingly on the application form,
