

Charity ride – Sunday 14th October 2018- Further information

START TIMES BETWEEN 10 am and 11 am for ride, 11 am and 12 noon for lead rein course

1. The venue for the ride is Westmorland County Showground. LA7 7NH
2. Please park where directed on the showground and do not ride or drive on the grass at the venue. Please ensure that all rubbish and manure is taken home
3. The route includes bridleways and lanes and some concessionary routes. Please be sure to heed the signs and markers. The lead rein course is around sections of the showground – this will be clearly marked on the day.
4. Fancy dress is optional, Riding hats (to current standards –these can be found at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/safety-and-accidents/common-incidents/what-to-wear/headwear>) must be worn and correctly fastened
5. All participants must hold Third Party Liability Insurance valid on the day of the event.
6. There are some stony sections on the route and riders will need to take appropriate care, both on these sections of the ride and at any road crossings. There are also some shallow water crossings.
7. Some, but not all of the gates on the ride will be manned to assist riders. However, on some sections, gates will not be manned. Please also be aware that some parts of the route are popular routes for dog walkers and ramblers – please be considerate to other users of the track!
8. The length of the ride is approximately 12 miles.
9. Maps will be available on the day.
10. If the weather leading up to the date of the ride is very wet or the ground conditions are unsatisfactory in the opinion of the organisers, the ride may be cancelled, in which case any cheques will be destroyed. Further details on this will be available nearer the time of the event.
11. Riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of the event.
